

Air Canada launching Montreal flights to Phoenix

[Air Canada](#) (TSE: AC) will launch seasonal flights between Montreal and Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport.

The flights will start next February and run until May. They will operate three days a week.

Airlines at Sky Harbor serve nine other Canadian cities including Vancouver, Edmonton, Calgary and Toronto.

Air Canada executives also announced new flights from Montreal to Lima, Peru.
